Community is a home of love Which can ensure us Heaven above Here we work together And avoid unnecessary blether.



The Annual day program of St. Ann's High School, Bolarum was held on 1st December 2022 with the theme 'NISARG' (Back to Nature).



NEW MISSION AT JHINJHARI


We are called for an Education and Pastoral Mission to this needy area of Katni District of Jabalpur Diocese.

Jesus said, "I have come, that you may have life, life in abundance." However, many families in this country do not enjoy life in fulness. Families are divided. Domestic violence, sexual abuse, harassment, etc. destroy peace in families today. Divorce cases are increasing. Catholic families are no exception.

Recently, when a husband filed a divorce petition, the wife who was staying with her parents due to harassment by the husband, could not afford to appoint an advocate. However, she approached me, and I agreed. When the

matter came up for hearing, I pleaded before the judge for mediation, and it was allowed. Through mediation, the husband agreed to withdraw the case. Life came alive again in that family. This was a bundle of joy to two minor children who are the greatest beneficiaries of this.

An advocate's work will end with mediation or withdrawal of the divorce petition. But for an advocate who is religious, thereafter starts the real mission. We have to do the follow-up.

In this way, legal aid apostolate can unite families and bring an abundance of life to the families as Jesus said.
